#### **A Program Designed for Individuals with Disabilities**

The services provided by the Centers for Independent Living (CILs) are designed to assist individuals with disabilities in identifying way to improve career opportunities and find permanent, integrated and competitive employment.

### ***Individual Services Available***

One-on-one and small group services are available to assist adults with disabilities with career selection, job search, and adjustment to work. Some of the learning themes are described below, but please note that these are meant as examples only. Please contact your local CIL for the current list of available services. Services are available to eligible individuals as approved by the Division of Vocational Rehabilitation Services.

#### **Orientation to Employment: Menu of Service Options\***

*Instruction and training are available in service areas such as Pre-Employment Instructional Support, Post-Secondary Job Training Resources; Social Skills: Keys to Obtaining & Retaining Jobs and Enriching Quality of Adult Life; Working Well with a Disability; and/or Budgeting and Banking.*

#### **Career Development and Work Readiness Planning: Menu of Service Options\***

*Instruction and training are available in service areas such as Employment Readiness Instructional Support, Navigating Governmental Resources for Training, Work and Funding, Community Based Work Experience; and/or Steps in Vocational Planning.*

#### **Transition to Employment: Menu of Service Options\***

*Instruction and training are available in service areas such as Fiscal Stewardship: Understanding Employee Benefits, Fiscal Compensation and Managing Finances; and/or Assistive Technology: Tools to Independence and Employment.*

#### **Post Placement Support Needs: Menu of Service Options\***

*Instruction and training are available in service areas such as Job Club; How to Maintain Employment; Time Management and Organization in the Workplace; and/or Conflict Resolution in the Workplace.*
